

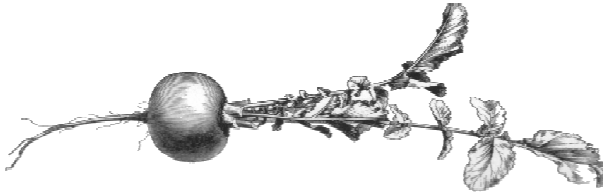

Underground Storage



Underground storage is typically found in two forms; direct burial and enclosed cellar. Direct burial is used mainly for root crops. You dig a hole in the ground, put the root crops in layered in twigs, and cover the top with flexible plastic and hay on top. Enclosed cellars are a little more permanent. You dig out a large, rectangular hole, build a large wood or brick frame around the edges, and add shelves for storage. Both methods keep food at a good storage temperature.
